

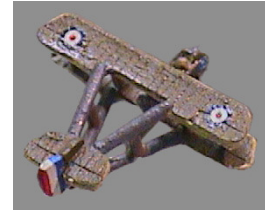

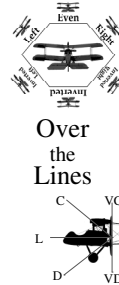

About 400 were built. AKA "The Spinning Incinerator" and the "De Havilland Scout". The D.H.2, with the Nieuport 11, was responsible for ending the "Fokker Scourge" and reviving the British air effort in 1916. It held air superiority until the advent of the Albatros fighters.
