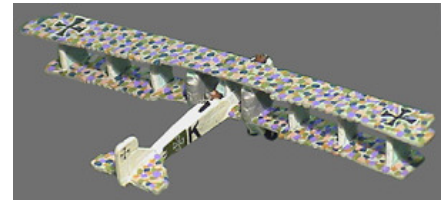
Gothaer Waggonfabrik Großkampfflugzeug G.III

Primarily used as a bomber. Großkampfflugzeug means "Large Battle Plane". A gun was specially mounted in a position to fire through a hole in the fuselage bottom -- quite a surprise for tailing fighters.

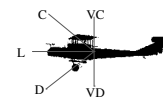
