Nicknamed "Bebe", "13-Meter Nieuport", "Nieuport Scout". The sesquiplane layout, with the small-chord lower wing, allowed excellent visibility. But the single-spar lower wing was prone to fail in rough maneuvers. With the D.H.2, the Nieuport 11 ended the "Fokker Scourge" in 1916.

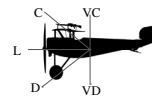
