As the Nieuport firm watched its dominance be eclipsed by SPAD, it abandoned its sesquiplane design in the Nieuport 28. During testing it was a disappointment, but there was a great demand for planes, so about 400 were built and used as fighters by France and the US. It frequently shed the fabric on the upper wing during violent maneuvers.
