

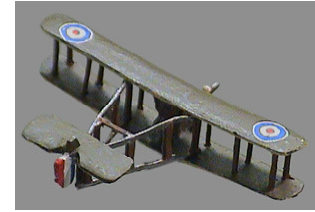

About 1,700 were built with this engine. Used as a fighter; and later for ground attack, reconnaissance, and light bombing. Nicknamed "Fee". The F.E.2b was well-respected by German pilots and groups of them were usually avoided.
