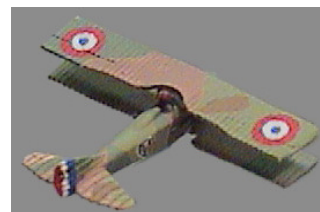

Special Rules: Guns can be fired separately or together.

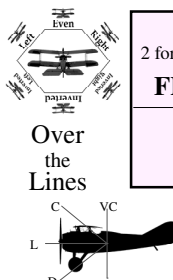
