

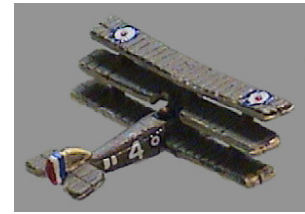

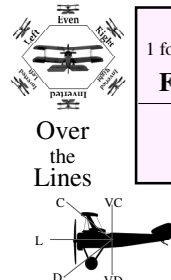

About 150 were built and used by Britain's R.N.A.S, primarily as a fighter. Nicknamed "Tripe", "Tripehound", and "Tripe Plane". The Triplane was very maneuverable and had good performance at all altitudes, and its appearance led the Germans to design several triplanes of their own, including the Fokker Dr.I.
